Cheryl has worked with Australia's leading Theatre companies like Sydney Theatre Company, Melbourne Theatre Company, Malthouse Theatre and Act Now Theatre.

She recently performed in "Do Rhinos Feel Their Horns? (or can they not see them like how we can't see our noses) produced by Singapore theatre company Gangguan! at the Edinburgh Fringe Festival, and Survivor Singapore by The Necessary Stage.

Her latest work "I Am Seaweed" in which she wrote and performed in, was presented by MASHH in partnership with Theatre Works and premiered at Melbourne Fringe 2023. The show was nominated for Best In Theatre, listed as one of the Fringe Judge's picks and received wonderful reviews.

Cheryl was awarded two Green Room Awards (Performer and Production) her one-woman show "落叶归根 *Getting Home"*. This work also received 4 awards at Melbourne Fringe 2020 (Best in Theatre, Best Emerging Writer, Best Emerging Producer and New Zealand Tour Ready Award) and Scenesavers best Digital Event at Brighton Fringe Festival 2022.

During her time at Artwave Studio, she wrote, pitched and performed in original works. Notable ones include "You're Invited", an interactive online experience on Gathertown at Esplanade's Huayi — Chinese Festival of Arts. And The Self-Compassion Lab at Design Orchard as part of the Realise Your Somerset Project (NYC) to empower youth creatives to do their best work.
